He became a pupil of Osti at Utrecht and was greatly influenced and inspired by the 17th century masters, Jan Van Der Heyden and the brothers Gerrit and Job Berckheyde.

He is represented in the Museums of Brussels, The Hague and Utrecht and in private collections throughout the world.
